RICHARDSON “DRIVER SAFETY” MATCHING GRANT PROGRAM.**

City Manager Cagle said the fire department would like to purchase back-up cameras for their vehicles through a matching grant from The Pool. She said the total cost is approximately \$2,500 and the City would be required to match 50% of the cost.

City Manager Cagle introduced Bridgett Raper to the Board. She said Ms. Raper is the Communications Strategist for the Small Cities Coalition of Hamilton County hired by the City of Soddy-Daisy and a few other municipalities in Hamilton County.

Commissioner Shipley thanked City Manager Cagle, Public Works Director Steve Grant, and State Representative Patsy Hazlewood for their persistence in getting the State of Tennessee to patch and eventually pave a section of Back Valley Road.

Commissioner Lowe questioned if the City could add “Stop Ahead” road markings for the intersection of Springfield Road and West Walden Circle. He said motorists continue to run the stop sign and there are several citizens who walk these streets on a daily basis. City Manager Cagle stated she will check with Public Works Director Grant on what can be done.

Commissioner Shipley said that he has not heard of any concerns on Hyatte Road recently and asked Police Chief Phillip Hamrick to verify. Police Chief Hamrick stated there have been no accidents.

Mayor Cothran also thanked City Manager Cagle, Public Works Director Steve Grant, and State Representative Patsy Hazlewood for their efforts.

Mayor Cothran announced that the caboose at the North Park has been removed.

Mayor Cothran said someone questioned him if the entrance to the Big Soddy Creek Golf could be further widened to allow golf carts. City Manager Cagle said the ordinance strictly prohibits golf carts.

Mayor Cothran questioned if the Board would like to cancel any of the commission meetings around Christmas and New Year’s. It was stated that it would be appropriate to cancel the meeting on December 21st and January 4th.
