2016-2017 ORDINANCE NO. 5

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF SODDY-DAISY, TENNESSEE,
AMENDING TITLE 12 OF THE SODDY-DAISY MUNICIPAL CODE BY ADDING A
NEW CHAPTER 6 ENTITLED "FIRE PREVENTION RAPID ENTRY
REQUIREMENT." SECOND AND FINAL READING.**

NEW BUSINESS:

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF SODDY-DAISY, TENNESSEE, TO AMEND
TITLE 8 OF THE SODDY-DAISY MUNICIPAL CODE RELATIVE TO THE SALE OF
WINE BY RETAIL FOOD STORES, AND PROVIDING FOR THE INSPECTION FEE
ALLOWED BY STATE LAW FOR THE SAME. FIRST READING.**

City Manager Cagle stated the sale of wine in retail food stores passed by referendum on the November 8th election. She said this ordinance is to add it to the Soddy-Daisy Municipal Code.

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF SODDY-DAISY, TENNESSEE,
AMENDING TITLE 8, CHAPTER 2 OF THE SODDY-DAISY MUNICIPAL CODE
REDEFINING THE TERM “BEER” TO BRING THE CODE INTO COMPLIANCE
WITH THE DEFINITION OF “BEER” IN THE TENNESSEE CODE. PUBLIC
HEARING AND FIRST READING.**

City Attorney Sam Elliott stated the State of Tennessee expanded the definition of beer to raise the alcohol content of the term “beer” from 5% to 8%. He said the Soddy-Daisy Municipal Code needs to be updated to reflect the change.

Citizens Participation:

Chris Harper, 408 Olivia Lane, presented a check from the Daisy Masonic Lodge No. 706 and the Daisy Chapter No. 328 Order of Eastern Star to Fire Chief Mike Guffey for \$311.50 to assist the Soddy-Daisy Volunteer Firefighters Association in their Christmas Gifts for Kids Program. Mr. Harper also announced that they would be having a Santa’s Workshop on Saturday, November 26th from 10:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. at the Daisy Masonic Lodge. He said there will be free arts & crafts and photos with Santa.

Vice-Mayor Cothran stated that the Christmas Parade will be Saturday, December 4th beginning at 2:00 p.m. He said staging will be on Frontage Road, Daisy Methodist Church and the “old” Erlanger Building parking lot. He said spectators will not be allowed south of the Daisy Church of God and signs will be posted in those areas.

Vice-Mayor Cothran announced that the Vietnam Veteran of America Chapter 942 will be donating \$2,000 to the Soddy-Daisy Volunteer Firefighters Association to assist in the Christmas Gifts for Kids Program.

Commissioner Adams questioned the status of the Christmas in the Park Celebration. Commissioner Shipley stated it would take place on December 3rd. He asked the Board if they would like the event to start at 3:30 p.m. and end at 7:00 p.m. and it was the consensus of the Board to do so. Commissioner Shipley asked if any of the Board opposed country music being sang in addition to Christmas music. He said it might help increase the attendance. Mayor Nunley said he thought it would be a good idea and people may stay longer. Commissioner Shipley stated that he would like to do a better job advertising for the event this year. He said he would like to get two 4 x 8 signs made to post the date and time of the event with the date portion of the sign to have the ability to be changed so the sign can be used from year to year.

Commissioner Adams thanked Fire Chief Guffey and the rest of the fire department for their hard work in the past few weeks in assisting with the wild fires. Mayor Nunley thanked the police department for their efforts providing security for the Forestry Department at the staging area.

Mayor Nunley announced that the commissioners will be sworn in at the next commission meeting and this was his last meeting as Mayor.
