The minutes of the regular meeting held November 5, 2015 were approved as presented.

Lieutenant Jeff Gann read letters of commendation that were being presented to Officer Jeremy Wright and Officer Jed Krider. Lieutenant Gann stated that Officer Wright was the first officer on the scene to answer a call for an unconscious male. Upon arrival Officer Wright saw a white male walking toward the residence and identified him as being on the Hamilton County Sheriff's Department fugitive warrant list. Lieutenant Gann stated that Officer Wright placed the felon under arrest and then continued into the house where Officer Wright and Officer Jed Krider performed CPR on the unconscious male. He said they were successful in bringing the gentleman back to life. Lieutenant Gann requested for Assistant Fire Chief Dusty Morgan to assist him in placing "lifesaver pins" on both officers' uniforms.

OLD BUSINESS:

NEW BUSINESS:

Adam Reynolds, representing the Hamilton County Water Quality Program, explained to the Board that the interlocal agreement needs to be amended to include the Town of Walden. He

stated the City of Soddy-Daisy would also need to pass an amended storm water ordinance. City Attorney Elliott gave background information on the regulations. He stated an amended ordinance will be prepared and voted on in January. Commissioner Shipley made a motion to approve the amended interlocal agreement, seconded by Commissioner Cothran and the ayes were unanimous.

Citizens Participation:

City Manager Cagle requested voucher approval to pay Southeastern Materials \$14,538.55 for asphalt to resurface the walking track at the Veterans Park and to repair various other areas in the City. Vice-Mayor Skates made a motion to approve, seconded by Commissioner Shipley and the ayes were unanimous.

City Manager Cagle requested voucher approval to pay Compass Materials of America \$16,023.01 for road salt. Commissioner Cothran made a motion to approve, seconded by Vice-Mayor Skates and the ayes were unanimous.

Commissioner Shipley commended Officer Jeremy Wright and Officer Jed Krider for their excellent work in the line of duty.

Vice-Mayor Patti Skates stated she was proud of Soddy-Daisy Middle School for their Veterans' Day Program. She congratulated all the JROTC groups that participated in the parade at Soddy-Daisy High School. She stated that she could not thank the veterans enough for their sacrifice and that she was proud to be a part of the City of Soddy-Daisy.

Commissioner Cothran announced that the Vietnam Veterans Chapter 942 will have their annual Christmas Dinner at Fire Hall #1 on Friday, December 11<sup>th</sup> at 6:00 p.m.

Commissioner Cothran said he spoke with the Soddy-Daisy High School band director and was informed that they will not participate in the parade this year due to being in Atlanta the day before.

Commissioner Cothran thanked everyone who participated in honoring veterans on Veterans' Day. He thanked Officer Jeremy Wright and Officer Jed Krider as well.

Commissioner Shipley stated that Santa Claus will be at Poe's Tavern the entire evening for the Christmas in the Park Celebration on Saturday, December 5<sup>th</sup>.

Vice-Mayor Skates encouraged everyone to witness the "Changing of the Guard" ceremony on Veterans' Day next year at the Soddy-Daisy Veterans Park hosted by the Sequoyah, Sale Creek, and Soddy-Daisy High School JROTCs.
