She stated that he came to City Hall to get a business license and it was discovered that he did not have the proper zoning.

City Manager Cagle requested voucher approval to pay Sherman Dixie \$5,405 for materials to resurface Rock Quarry Road. Commissioner Shipley made a motion to approve pay, seconded by Commissioner Cothran and the ayes were unanimous.

City Manager Cagle requested voucher approval to pay Card's Paving \$16,321 to place asphalt on Rock Quarry Road. Commissioner Cothran made a motion to approve pay, seconded by Commissioner Shipley and the ayes were unanimous.

City Manager Cagle requested voucher approval to pay Rogers Group \$12,834.32 for rock to resurface Rock Quarry Road. Commissioner Shipley made a motion to approve pay, seconded by Commissioner Adams and the ayes were unanimous.

Commissioner Shipley asked Public Works Director Steve Grant for the status of moving the caboose at the North Park. Public Works Director Grant said he received three quotes but is waiting on City Manager Cagle to obtain some rail from Norfolk Southern. Commissioner Shipley stated the caboose is being moved to open up the area where it currently sits for musical acts and other such activities.

Commissioner Cothran announced that the armored personnel carrier is in place at the Veterans' Park.

Vice-Mayor Skates stated that it was Public Works Week and asked Public Works Director Grant to thank his employees for all they do for the City.
