Citizens Participation:

Pete D'Amico 277 Brumlow Hollow Road, informed the Board that his road is in need of repair. He said the damage to the road is due to vandalism from his neighbor. City Manager Stulce asked Mr. D'Amico if he had contacted Public Works Director Grant or the Police Chief about the problem. Mr. D'Amico stated that he had only contacted Commissioner Shipley. Mayor Cagle told Mr. D'Amico when he needs to report a problem of this nature that he needs to call the City Manager or the Police Chief not a Commissioner. She said there is nothing they can do about it.

City Manager Stulce said "we" had a preconstruction conference yesterday in regard to the traffic signals on Sequoyah Road and work is scheduled to commence on Monday, August 19th.

Commissioner Skates requested for Police Chief Phillip Hamrick to check and see how many calls and arrests have been made from the trailer park on Wal-Mart Drive in the past year. She said there continues to be problems coming from that area. Commissioner Skates said she has received reports of people running through other people's back yards late at night. She said there are some safety concerns with residents on Cox Lane.

Commissioner Adams reminded the Board of the Tennessee River Bridge Meeting on Wednesday, August 21st in the Commission Room at the Hamilton County Courthouse.

Commissioner Adams announced there will be a public forum concerning the Soddy-Daisy Industrial Park on Thursday, August 29th at 6:00 p.m. Mayor Cagle said there will be discussion about erecting a new sign for the industrial park among other topics.

Vice-Mayor Nunley said there will be a Parks and Recreation Board meeting on Wednesday, August 21st at 6:00 p.m.

Mayor Cagle requested for Police Chief Hamrick to give the Board a report on the status of the codes enforcement violations as soon as possible.
