City Manager Cagle requested approval to pay an invoice from Blue Ridge Voice & Data for \$12,443 to replace the audio recorder for the police department. Vice-Mayor Skates made a motion to approve, seconded by Commissioner Cothran and the ayes were unanimous.

City Manager Cagle informed the Board that the City is preparing to pave Durham Street and sections of Depot Street and Dallas Hollow Road. She stated that Street Aid Funds will be used to fund the projects.

Police Chief Phillip Hamrick provided a 6 month report from the police department. He noted that his department had a 78.6% clearance rate for the time period. He said the police department answered 2,483 calls in the month of July.

Commissioner Cothran thanked the public works department for all their efforts to keep roads open during the recent rain.

Mayor Nunley informed the Board that TDOT has been contacted in regard to the hydroplaning issue on Highway 27, north of the Hixson Pike exit. He stated that they are trying to devise a solution to alleviate the hazard.

Mayor Nunley informed everyone in attendance that the City of Soddy-Daisy was recently recognized in an article as one of the safest and most peaceful cities in Tennessee.
