Mayor Nunley announced that Vice-Mayor Skates had resigned her post earlier today to be effective immediately.

The minutes of the regular meeting held September 1, 2016 were approved as presented.

OLD BUSINESS:

Citizens Participation:

Jinnie Henry, 1445 Bowman Road, presented the Board with a petition with seven signatures requesting the City to de-annex their properties on Bowman Road. Commissioner Shipley stated that the City has several locations where one side of the road is in the City and the other side of the road is not. He said the City advertised the de-annexation of the roadway on Bowman Road on April 24, 2014 and had readings on May 1, 2014 and May 15, 2014. Commissioner Shipley said he is not in favor of de-annexing these properties. He said it would start a precedent. Commissioner Shipley stated that the City has continued to mow the right-of-

way on Bowman Road and the residents receive fire, police and garbage service. Ms. Henry questioned why the City de-annexed Indian Ridge Road several years ago. City Manager Cagle stated that part of the road was in the City, part of the road was out, and then part of the road was back in again. Commissioner Cothran said he has had many conversations with Bill Layne about this subject. He said he was in a similar situation for many years on Dallas Hollow Road. Commissioner Cothran said he would not make a motion to de-annex these properties but would not stand in the way of it either. Commissioner Adams stated that these properties pay City taxes and should receive all the same services as everyone else. It was the consensus of the Board to continue to mow the right-of-way and scrape the road when it snows.

City Manager Cagle requested voucher approval to pay Consolidated Pipe \$7,562.88 for fire hydrant parts. Commissioner Adams made a motion to approve, seconded by Commissioner Cothran and the ayes were unanimous.

Mayor Nunley opened the floor for nominations for Vice-Mayor. Commissioner Adams nominated Commissioner Cothran, seconded by Commissioner Shipley and the ayes were unanimous.

Vice-Mayor Cothran gave a report of his trip to Louisiana. He stated approximately \$21,000 was raised for the relief effort for flood victims in Louisiana. He said he has already received thank you cards from some of the people they were able to help. Vice-Mayor Cothran stated these cards thanked the Vietnam Veterans of America Chapter 942 but the thanks should go out to the community of Soddy-Daisy. He said our community really stepped up.

Commissioner Adams thanked Vice-Mayor Cothran for spear heading the relief effort. Mayor Nunley thanked him as well.

Commissioner Shipley stated the Board has not made a decision as to the location of the Christmas Parade. He said they will do everything they can to not move it. He said conversations need to be had with the contractor to discuss safety issues and other hindrances.
