Mayor Adams stated the meeting was called to discuss paving roads. He asked Finance Director Burt Johnson how much money was in the budget for paving. Finance Director Johnson stated there was \$250,000. He said due to a potential cash flow shortage until December 31, 2012, that it was his recommendation to spend \$100,000 to \$125,000 on paving in 2012 and wait until the Spring of 2013 to do the remainder. Mayor Adams asked the other Board members which roads would they like to pave. There was some discussion between Board members as to which roads they felt needed paving. City Manager Stulce asked if the Board would like to dedicate some of the paving funds to expand the parking lot and the North Park and repave it. After some discussion, it was a consensus of the Board to hold off doing anything to the parking lot and use the funds to pave roads. Vice-Mayor Cagle made a motion to pave Porter Street, Lou Lane, Depot Street from Dayton Pike to School Street and Depot Street from Oak Street to Wall Street, seconded by Commissioner Nunley and the ayes were unanimous.
